Fiji operates on a voltage of 240V with a frequency of 50Hz. The plug type commonly used is the Australian/New Zealand Type I. This means travellers from Australia and New Zealand won't need a ...

If you are traveling to Fiji with electronic devices that use a different plug type, you will need to bring a travel adapter. It's important to note that while Fiji uses a voltage of 240 volts, many devices are dual ...

Ensure your devices have compatible plugs or bring an appropriate power adapter to use them in Fiji. Power Adapter for Fiji? To determine whether you need a power adapter for your trip to Fiji, consider ...

Fiji has Type I power plugs with 240 V AC 50 Hz - see Fiji travel adapters here. If you're coming from New Zealand or Australia (where most visitors to Fiji are from), you will not need a travel ...

In Fiji, type I power outlets are used, while in USA, you use plugs A and B. If you're traveling to Fiji, you'll need a power adapter for types I, as your power plugs won't fit the sockets there.

North Americans will need an adapter for the outlets and a transformer for the voltage when traveling to Fiji. North Americans device plugs will not work with the outlet types in Fiji.

Generally, Fiji has a reliable power supply. However, like many tropical destinations, occasional power outages can happen. Resorts and major urban areas usually have backup generators to mitigate ...
