

Like most countries in the Caribbean and North and Central America, Guyana uses American-style plugs (types A and B), which are standard throughout the region for convenience and ...

This guide will help you understand the different types of plugs and sockets used in Guyana and how they compare to those you use at home, so you can be sure you have the right adapter for your trip.

Before you embark on your adventure, it's crucial to ensure your electronic devices are compatible with the local power system. A compatible power adapter will safeguard your valuable gadgets and allow ...

You can't use your electric appliances in Guyana without a voltage converter, because the standard voltage in Guyana is higher than in the United States of America (120 V).

When it comes to buying a power adapter for Guyana, you need to consider a few factors. Guyana uses Type A and Type B electrical outlets with a standard voltage of 120V.

You will be able to plug the devices directly in Guyana (please read other sections of this reports in regards to voltage, etc.). Perhaps you will need adapters for some sockets, but it is usually easier to ...

Since you'll need a travel adapter for Guyana when coming from USA, we suggest opting for a universal power adapter that works in many countries and will also prepare you for future trips.

Travelers from countries with a standard voltage between 100 V and 127 V, such as Canada, Japan, the US, and South America, will require a voltage converter to use electric appliances in Guyana.

Guyana uses electrical outlets and power plugs of types A, B, D & G (see images). If your country uses the same electrical outlets and power plugs, you don't need a travel adapter.

North Americans may need an adapter for the outlets and a transformer for the voltage when traveling to Guyana. North Americans device plugs will not work with the outlet types in Guyana.
