As long as it is factory window tint, which is a color in the glass, then after market window film can be installed directly on the glass. Aftermarket window film has many more solar benefits than factory window tint.

The difference is that window films are generally a retrofit option, intended to fix a problem with excessive solar heat gain and/or solar glare from an existing window while window coatings are generally applied in a glass ...

In most cases a non-reflective window film will match perfectly to the factory tint on the rear glass. The aftermarket, professionally installed films by Autobahn(TM) prevent 99.9% solar heat, and UVA and UVB from ...
