

Baltic Storage Platform, a joint venture (JV), has broken ground on two new 200MW/400MWh battery energy storage systems (BESS) in Estonia.

Estonia's state-owned energy company, Eesti Energia, has officially launched the country's largest battery energy storage system at the Auvere industrial complex in Ida-Viru County.

To assess the potential of battery storage in selected building types, a detailed hourly simulation was conducted to evaluate self-consumption of PV-generated energy and its impact on the building's EPC.
