

Are solar project delays trending down?

Delays in bringing these solar projects into operation have been trending down in recent months. Despite the relatively high number of projects reporting delays in 2024, that year was a record year for U.S. solar capacity additions.

What is solar power & why is it so important?

Solar power is the fastest-growing source of new electric generating capacity in the United States, driven by large-scale solar photovoltaic (PV) projects built by electric utilities and independent power producers. Are solar project delays more common than cancellations?

Delays in solar project schedules tend to be relatively short in duration, and reports of delays are more common than cancellations: less than 1% of planned solar capacity is entirely cancelled in a typical month.
