

Is there a tax refund point for photovoltaic panel exports

The government slashed the export tax rebate for solar products from 13% down to 9%. That's a 4-percentage-point drop that hit manufacturers right in their margins.

On November 15, China's Ministry of Finance and the State Administration of Taxation announced a reduction in the export tax rebate rate for certain products, including refined oil, ...

In China, the value-added tax (VAT) policy for solar projects follows a unique "levy-and-refund" model. Since 2016, PV manufacturers have paid a 13% VAT rate but received a 50% refund upon tax filing .

Current Tax Refund Rate for Photovoltaic Exports As of December 1, 2024, China's export tax refund rate for photovoltaic panels stands at 9%, marking a significant reduction from the previous 13% rate.
