Do shippers have trouble booking shipping capacity during the low season?

The interviewee revealed that shippers have no trouble booking shipping capacity during the low season due to overcapacity. To maximize load, shipping carriers compromise to lower prices.

How has the global economic recession affected container transport?

Since multiple adverse factors such as geopolitical conflicts, the global economic recession has worsened, the slowing growth rate of ocean transport negatively affected the demand for container transportation market, and freight rates have continued to fall to pre-epidemic levels.

Why do shippers re-weigh their capacity in low season?

The results show that the mechanism encourages the shipper to re-weigh their actual capacity in low season. It enables the shipper to increase their committed capacity quantity and facilitates the carrier to maintain the benefits of planning capacity in advance.

How does a shipper allocate capacity in high season?

As the low and high seasons arrive successively, the shipper purchases the contracted commitment quantity of capacity in low season as agreed upon, and the carrier, subsequently allocates capacity to the shipper in high season based on the purchased capacity during low season, adhering to the proportional requirement coefficient.
