

What is SMUD's residential solarshares program?

SMUD's residential SolarShares program lets you enjoy all the benefits of solar without a solar system on your roof. SMUD has developed local solar generation resources that supply 100% clean solar energy to all program participants.

How does SMUD pay for solar panels?

If your solar panels make electricity you don't need right away, it gets sent to your neighbors by way of the wires outside your house. Under SMUD's Solar and Storage Rate, that electricity is purchased by the utility for \$0.074/kWh, no matter what time it is produced.

How much does SMUD charge per kWh?

The SSR shares the Time of Day rate's increased pricing during peak times and establishes a rate of 7.4 cents per kWh that SMUD pays customers for excess solar electricity they don't use in their home. Depending on the time of day, 7.4 cents is roughly 33% to 77% less than the retail price customers pay for electricity from SMUD.
