Four major operators control the mobile services market. Tunisia's largest telecom company is Ooredoo(Orascom Telecom Tunisia). In 2022,Tunisie Telecom had 39.7% of the market,Ooredoo 37.4%,and Orange Tunisie 22.9%. Lycamobile had an insignificant market share.

Does Tunisia have a competitive market for foreign companies?

The playing field for foreign companies operating in Tunisia remains fair,with no evident competitive advantage for the state-owned telecom company,Tunisie Telecom. Four major operators control the mobile services market. Tunisia's largest telecom company is Ooredoo (Orascom Telecom Tunisia).
